Class Chaperone Expectations

Class Chaperones are an irreplaceable part of Spring Recital! RCD Dancers (Co 3, 4, 5, and Unbound) will be called to chaperone classes during Spring Recital. Show/Class assignments have been laid out above.

This is a task of great responsibility, care, and attention! Class Chaperones will assist dancers from arrival all the way to dismissal. RCD dancers will not likely be the only chaperones present. Typically, there will be 1-2 parent chaperones assisting each class as well.

Chaperoning will look like:

- Ensuring dancers make it to their designated dressing rooms.
- Assisting with hair and makeup needs if they arise.
- Assisting dancers with bathroom breaks as needed.
- Connecting with dancers, helping calm pre-show nerves, and contributing to the fun and exciting environment that is Spring Recital!
- Making sure dancers are prepped in the wings and make it on stage for their big moment!
- After the show, staying with the class and ensuring dancers make it to their designated dismissal zone.
